

Georeferenced Pomfret Map

A georeferenced map is one that is tied into specific latitude/longitude coordinates so that it can show exact locations when using it. At the bottom of this page, you will find a link to a georeferenced pdf map of the Town of Pomfret that was made to be used with a free smartphone map app such as Avenza. Cell phone reception is not needed for this map to work, but you do need to be within the area referenced in the map. Avenza will work on iPhones and Android phones.

When you open the map, you will see a blue dot representing where you are located as you move through Pomfret. The map shows various public recreational areas, as well as streams, ponds, and property lines. Please respect property owners.

The map is a large file, and I recommend storing the file on Google Drive, Dropbox or iCloud so that it is easily accessible from your smart phone. The free version of the Avenza app will hold up to three georeferenced maps.

First download the Avenza app onto your smart phone from your smart phone app store. Once the app is downloaded, open it up. Touch the “+” button. Select the place where your stored the map. You will see links for “Dropbox”, “From Storage Locations” or “URL”. It may take a long time to upload the map because it is large. If you use Google Drive, select Storage Locations.
